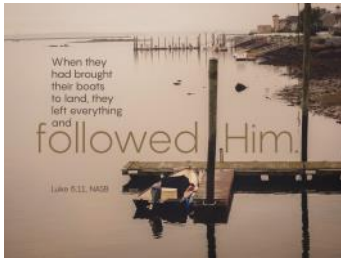
IN THE SIGHT OF THE ANGELS I WILL SING YOUR PRAISES, LORD

They recognize their own lowliness in the face of the Lord's majesty. Paul reminds us that Christ died for our sins and was raised. When we confess our sinfulness, we also acknowledge God's power to forgive us.



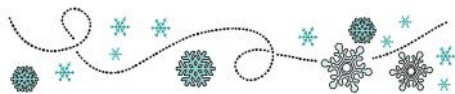
